Vocabulary is known to be one of the Big 6, the key components that contribute to both oral and written literacy development, from beginning readers through all primary and secondary grades.

However, there are many students with learning difficulties who face barriers to developing the fundamental vocabulary skills needed for all aspects of learning. It may be that they have poor literacy, language, attention and/or auditory processing abilities, so that they are regularly disadvantaged in attending to, retaining and subsequently using new and unfamiliar vocabulary presented both orally and in print.

Every primary and secondary teacher can incorporate Explicit Vocabulary Instruction into their everyday teaching strategies. At home, parents can also provide vocabulary rich environments to support communication and learning development.

In this seminar we will explore how we learn new words, how vocabulary instruction can be included in all subject areas (yes, even Maths!) and how we can prioritise essential vocabulary.
