Autistic children and adolescents may perceive, think, learn and relate differently. This seminar will initially review the main characteristics of autism, including how some autistic students camouflage their autism at school.

Then four themes will be explored:

- 1. Learning profiles associated with autism and adjustments to the curriculum
- 2. The perception and regulation of emotions, especially anxiety
- 3. Managing a meltdown
- 4. Autistic qualities

The seminar will also consider how the profile of autistic abilities changes over time, especially during and after puberty and the effects of bullving and teasing.
